



**"GHETTO STREETBIKE FREESTYLE" Competitions – BIGGEST INTERNATIONAL OF THE  
EASTERN EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP**

**COMPETITION REGULATIONS**

**Main info:**

This paper defines the main principles, ground rules and necessary procedures for the "Ghetto Streetbike Freestyle" Competitions – Biggest international of the Eastern European Championship". Streetbike Freestyle competitions showcase individual athletes competing against each other by performing stunts on a motorcycle in an area secured in thought of the safety of the event audience.

**1. Organizers and event managers:**

Competition is organized by the association "STREETBASKET" in close collaboration with the sports marketing center "Motorsport Media & Marketing".

Main organizer - Raimonds Elbakjans

Event manager - Didzis Grundulis

Judges: Janis Rozitis (Latvia), Virginijus Zukauskas (Lithuania), Lauris Klebahs (Latvia).

**2. Main goals:**

The main goal of the competition is to promote an athletic and healthy lifestyle among young people, also to help develop and promote the sport of Streetbike Freestyle in Latvia and the rest of Eastern Europe. Along with the main goal the event is set to determine the best overall Streetbike Freestyle professionals and ensure valuable experience for upcoming athletes.

**3. Time and place:**

Ghetto Games Festival, Ventspils, Latvia. Lielais Prospekts street.

21st of July, 2024.

**- 4. Participants and applications:**

- The competition is open to any and all athletes willing to participate. The participants are obligated to have suitable equipment and be at least the age of 16. Also it is a necessity for each participant to have obtained the required skills for entering a competition of this level of expertise. Participation in the competition is free of charge. All participants will be set in a single group, regardless of age and gender. Participant registration form for the competition can be filled out until June 21. - **By registering as a participant and/or entering the competition each competitor certifies that:**
- **valid personal information is provided to the organizers of the event;**
- **he/she is familiar with all regulations of the competition and agrees to follow these regulations;**
- **he/she is aware that participation in the event is a high danger risk, leading to the possibility of physical injury, and fatal outcome cannot be excluded;**
- **his/her current physical condition is appropriate to the degree of difficulty of stunts performed;**
- he/she takes full responsibility for the result of my his/her own actions which may be in violation of this declaration, along with any injuries, physical and material damage, etc.
- he/she releases the organizers of any responsibility during the event if any damage to him/her may occur, same for all personal belongings.

### **5. Safety rules:**

Participants and spectators are personally responsible for their safety, health and following all safety regulations. The participants of the competition and any spectators are prohibited on the course during the competition, excluding a situation in which they are invited on the course by the hosts of the event.

Participants of the competition are obliged to use the following safety gear:

- Helmet;
- Back guard or a special jacket with a back guard;
- Gloves;
- The organizers recommend the use knee pads or special trousers with knee pads.

It is prohibited to participate in the competition or be of attendance at the secured area of competition while intoxicated by any drugs or alcohol. The organizers have the right to call on health care professionals to check in case there is any suspicion of a person being under the influence of any drugs or alcohol. Participants who violate these rules will be immediately disqualified.

The quality of the competition is under the responsibility of 3 main judges who are located in the judges sector during the competition, as well as an extra judge who is responsible for the signal flags and is located at the starting position of the competition course.

The signal flags are used to inform on the following:

Green flag – course is free, it is allowed to start;

Red flag – performance must be stopped;

Yellow flag – 1 minute until the end of time given for the performance.

During the competition, participants are prohibited from using any liquids that could affect the surface of the course.

### **6. Technical specifications:**

All motorcycles used during the competition must meet the following requirements:

- Motors - 550cc min;

- Cylinders - 2 min;
- Motorcycles must be in running order, any fluid leaking is not acceptable.

The technical condition of the motorcycles and other equipment is a subject to inspection by a technician designated by the event organizers.

### **7. Schedule of the event:**

- Set-up process for the athletes area
- Participants briefing (attendance is a must for all participants of the competition)
- Participants draw out the order they will perform in
- Obligatory practice (attendance is a must for all participants of the competition)
- Qualifying runs
- The finalists' meeting
- Practice before the finals
- *Janis Rozitis Stunt Show*
- *Stoppie competition*
- The finals
- Awards ceremony

### **8. Competition format:**

All participants must participate in the official training sessions, the time of which will be issued prior to the competition by the organizers of the event.

Number plates assigned to the participants by the organizers must be attached to notably clothing and the motorcycle during the whole day of the competition.

An assistant of the event organizers is responsible for the start/finish signals during the competition. The order in which the participants perform along with a precise timetable will be noted during the participants briefing shortly before the competition.

Qualification runs as well as the finals of the competition are carried out in a „freestyle” manner.

#### Qualification runs:

The order in which participants perform during the qualification runs shall be determined by a simple draw. In qualifying every athlete will be given 3 minutes for the execution of their freestyle performance.

#### Event finals:

Competitors with the highest qualifying scores participate in the finals. The number of finalists depends on the total number of participants and shall be announced before the qualification runs begin. The starting order during the finals is determined by the results of the qualification runs - first goes the participant with the lowest qualifying score, the last participant to perform is one with the highest qualification score. During the finals each rider will be given 4 minutes for the execution of their freestyle performance. Before the final runs, each participant will have 30 seconds for warm-up. A minute before a run in the finals is about to end, the yellow signal flag is shown by one of the judges.

#### Additional disciplines:

The *Stoppue* competition will be held after the qualification of the freestyle competition.

### 8. Judges and scoring:

Race organizers selected the 3 judges, qualifiers and finals each of the:

1. Stunt accuracy (Max 10 points). The most points can be achieved by the rider who performs the most accurate and clean stunts. Each fall subtracts 5 points, each incomplete trick subtracts 2 points.
2. Stunt complexity (Max 20 points). More points can be earned by extreme, high-speed and more acrobatic stunts.
3. Stunt Diversity (Max 20 points). There are 4 basic disciplines of stunts: tricks executed on the rear wheel (Max 5 points), tricks executed on the front wheel (Max 5), drifting (Max 5), different acrobatic elements (Max 5).
4. The rider's style, originality, and their performance as a whole (Max 10 points).

The results are calculated from all 3 judges scores.

If a participant does not begin his performance after the start signal or goes on with his run after the finish signal, 15 points will be deducted. All stunts that are in motion before the finish signal can be completed.

If competitors have the same final scores the qualification results are taken into account.

During the *Gymkhana* competition all participants start the trick at the same time. The winner is one who is first to finish.

### 9. Prize purse:

1st place - 500EUR

2nd place - 400EUR

If for some reason the competition can not be completed, the main judge may decide to reward the competitors based on the results available at that moment.

### 10. Disqualification:

The participant may be disqualified from the competition for the following reasons:

- If a participant is intoxicated by any drugs or alcoholic substances (the organizer has the right to decide on the disqualification);
  - Failure to comply with the rules of the competition laid down and/or the organizers and judges' instructions;
  - The event organizer has the right to decide on the competitor's participation in any future competitions and disqualify an individual from one or all of the remaining stages of the championship.
- Organizer's decision is final.
