

## SUPERMOTO REGULATION 2026

### of Individual Latvian/Estonian and Baltic SM championship 1<sup>th</sup> round 31.05.2026.

Supermoto regulation (hereinafter referred to as Regulation) of Open Individual Championship define the procedures and principles according to which Supermoto competitions shall be organized .

#### 1. GENERAL RULES

**1.1. Regulation is based on the FMN (National federations) Championships regulations, racing and technical terms, this statute, and the individual championships in this part of stage race regulations, which must not be inconsistent with this regulation.**

1.2. Organizers have to approved round regulation in own federation and after that have to send it out for all other national federations, not later than two weeks before the race.

**1.3. Latvian/Estonian Championship 1<sup>th</sup> round. Baltic SM championship 1<sup>th</sup> round.**

3.2. Championship event begin at the scheduled time for technical and sporting verifications and end when all of the following have occurred: a) The final results have been approved ; b) All deadlines for lodging protests and also appeals have expired. c) All technical, sporting and anti-doping controls have been concluded .

### 3.4.Results / Procedure

3.4.1.All official outings of the riders on the circuit must be timed, with the results displayed on monitors and communicated to the press.

3.4.2.Timing shall continue until:

- 5 minutes after the end of each practice or timed qualifying session;
- 5 minutes after the arrival of the winner of the race in question.

3.4.3. The winner of a race is the rider who crosses the finish line first.

3.3.4. Races are officially ended at the completion of the lap at which the chequered flag is displayed to the winner.

3.4.5. The riders who follow the winner will then be stopped when crossing the finishing line.

3.4.6. The time at which a motorcycle crosses a control line shall be registered at the moment the foremost part of the motorcycle crosses the line.

3.4.7. When crossing control lines, the rider must always be in contact with the motorcycle.

3.5. Results / Awarding of Points Championships.

Points will be awarded to riders in Championship Race according to the following scale:

<b>25 points to the 1st</b>	<b>22 points to the 2nd</b>
<b>20 points to the 3rd</b>	<b>18 points to the 4th</b>
<b>16 points to the 5th</b>	<b>15 points to the 6th</b>

### 3.6.Results / Final Standings

3.6.1. In each class, the winner of the Championship event is the rider who has obtained the most points; the runner-up will be the rider who has obtained the second best number of points, and so on, irrespective of the number of races they have finished.

3.6.2.If a tie exists, the points scored in the Race 2 will determine the order of placing in the final standings of the event of those riders who scored points.

### 4. Awarding

4.1. Championship competitions will count towards the final standings also as national championships and national cup.

4.3. Riders winning 1st, 2nd or 3rd places of Championship are awarded with gold, silver and bronze medals, cups and diplomas.

4.4. Winners are awarded according to competition regulations. Awards are presented at least to the first three places in each class (with cups in sizes from 35cm-45cm).

4.5. Awarded riders must obligatorily participate in the prize-giving ceremony and **attend it wearing their racing leather suit.**

4.5.1. The official Prize-Giving Ceremony must be held 30 minutes after the last race of the event, conditions and time permitting.

4.6. Each competition organizer can set up own prize fund.

4.8. Each rider from classes: SM50; SM65; SMJUNIOR (65cc and 85cc) Pit bike Junior and MINIMOTO class are awarded with medal and organizer prize for participation.

### 5. Entries

5.1. Entries must be made on-line via <https://sfrt.lv/content/27-registracija-3005> platform. Online registration will open 12.05.2026 and closes 23.05.2026.

## 7. Protests and appeals .

7.1. All protests must be lodged to the Race Jury.

7.2. Generally, protests the eligibility of a rider, entrant or a motorcycle entered, must be made before the start of the official practice.

7.3. A protest, submitted in written form together with a deposit fee of EUR 150, must be lodged within 30 minutes after the publication of the results.

7.4. If the protest entails dismantling a motorcycle, the protest fee must be accompanied by an additional deposit of € 500.-. This fee must be paid by the losing party to the mechanic of the rider who had to open the engine.

## 8. Other

8.2. Organisers are responsible for providing all facilities and personnel to ensure the safe, smooth and efficient running of the event.

Such as :

8.3. The paddock must be fully operational as of one day before the scheduled time for technical and sporting verifications.

8.3.1. Smoking is prohibited in the Technical Control post, Pitline and waiting zone.; No smoking; signs should be installed at the entrance of these zone.

8.3.2. The riders' paddock must be equipped with a minimum 2 toilets.

8.3.3. Electricity is provided at the circuit (min 220watts) and its installations, safety guidelines are recommended. The electricity must be provided free of charge.

**Rules of the Supermoto Championship - entry procedure and stay in the participant's camp.**

**Madona 30.05.-31.05.2026.**

- Entry and exit to the participants camp on **30.05.2026 from 9:00 to 23:00 and 31.05.2026. from 6:00;**
- While in the participants camp, silence must be observed during the night hours from 23:00 to 6:00.
- Movement in the territory of the participant 39; camp with means of transport (car, motorcycle, bicycle, pit bike, etc.) is allowed at a speed of no more than 5 km/h;
