**11. Safety requirements:**

11.1. Riders and spectators are personally responsible for complying with safety regulations.

**12. Winners:**

12.1. Riders are awarded points for each race according to the following table:

10.1. Team Classification: Points for riders in the Lithuanian Championship classes are awarded for each race according to the following table:

10.2. All riders who start in the final races and complete at least 51% of the laps of the class winner receive points and a placing. Other riders receive only a placing.

10.3. The placing in the individual Lithuanian Championship stage is determined by the highest total points accumulated over two (or one) races. In case of a tie, priority is given to the rider with the higher placing in the second race.

10.4. The placing in the team classification of a Lithuanian Championship stage is determined by the higher total points scored by team members, calculated from the best 7 race results of the stage. In case of a tie, priority is given to the team whose riders have more higher (1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc.) positions in the individual classification. If still tied, the result of the second race in the MX1 class is used. If no riders started in MX1, the order is determined by MX2, then 125, 85, 65, and 50 classes.

10.5. A rider may participate in two classes at a Lithuanian Championship stage, but only the better final results of one class count towards the team classification. A rider cannot compete in two classes on the same day.

## 11. Awards:

11.1. Riders finishing in the top three positions in each class in the Baltic Championship receive trophies and sponsor prizes (if provided).

11.2. Riders finishing in the top three positions in each class in the Lithuanian Championship receive awards as specified in the main competition regulations.

11.3. The cash prize fund for a Lithuanian Championship stage is awarded to winners and podium finishers of the following classes:

11.3.1. "85", "65", "Women" classes:

1st place – €100

2nd place – €70

3rd place – €50

11.3.2. "125", "MX2", "MX2J" classes:

1st place – €150

2nd place – €100

3rd place – €50

11.3.3. "MX1" class:

1st place – €200

2nd place – €150

3rd place – €100

11.4. For the top three positions in the Lithuanian Championship team classification, teams are awarded as specified in the main competition regulations.

## 12. Award ceremony:

12.1. Location Award podium at the track

## 13. Financial Conditions:

13.1. All expenses related to riders' participation in the Lithuanian Championship are covered by the sending organization (club) or by the rider themselves; if competing individually, the rider covers all costs.

13.2. For pre-registered riders with a personal transponder, the Lithuanian Championship entry fee for one event is €60; for motorcycle class "50", €50. For riders without a personal transponder, the entry fee is €60 plus transponder rental €10; for class "50", €50 plus transponder rental €10. Payment should be transferred to the organizer's account at least two days before the event (by Thursday 23:59).

13.3. For registration on the event day or if the pre-registration fee has not been paid:

With a personal transponder: €70 for one race; class "50" €60.

Without a personal transponder: €70 plus €10 transponder rental; class “50” €60 plus €10 transponder rental.

14. **Protests and Appeals:**

Protests and appeals are submitted according to Lithuanian Motocross rules.

15. **Interpretation of Regulations:**

In case of a dispute during the competition, only the Chief Race Judge may interpret the regulations.

16. **Additional:**

Pre-registration at [www.e-lmsf.lt](http://www.e-lmsf.lt) by logging into your personal account is open until 2026-05-28 23:59. Pre-registration closes two (2) days before the start of the event; after that, registration is possible only on the day of the event.
